WE GATHER AT THE RIVER

On Saturday, July 17, the first of the regional Presbytery Partnership Gatherings (PPG) was held at First Pres., New Brunswick. Due to the extreme heat and humidity, the group did not go to Johnson Park but remained on church premises. The plenary speaker Richard Bizub, Director for **Pinelands** Water Programs, Preservation Alliance. topic, "The Pine Barrens: 'Up Close & Natural" provided a sound foundation on this unique New Jersey area using lecture, video and Q&A. Following a lunch provided by Elijah's Promise, Sean Monahan of the law firm Drinker and Biddle addressed some of the sacramental uses of water, followed by a presentation on environmental issues involving water, its usage, contamination, and ways in which we can "reuse, reduce and recycle" to benefit our landfills and water resources.

During social time women from the various Presbyteries in New Jersey joined in a songfest of music which mentioned "river" or water. The finale was a rousing duet of the Rutgers alma mater "On the Banks of the Olde Raritan."

The worship service was led by Rev. Phyllis Zoon. Joann Burrell was commissioned as a delegate to the PC(USA) mission experience to South Dakota.
