Roe Vickery, *MoonCatcher Project* Grant Writing Committee Chair will speak on the establishment of sewing cooperatives in undeveloped countries to make reusable menstrual hygiene products.

Fatmata Hilton, President of *Susu Women's Club* and member of *Westminster Presbyterian Women* will speak on the issues in Liberia and Sierra Leone (her native country) that prevent girls from getting an education.

Lyn Kucij, a Physician Assistant, will speak on the educational program that accompanies the distribution of *MoonCatchers* reusable menstrual hygiene kits.
